

## **TTA Zone II Bylaws**

Be it known that as directed by Texas Trapshooters Association, that the membership of Zone II shall elect three (3) officers a year, consisting of a President, Vice-President, and Secretary/Treasurer. Any two (2) Zone Officers shall serve on the Board of Directors of the Texas Trapshooters Association.

Secondly, be it known that these officers should hold a minimum of one meeting each year. This meeting will be announced by notice to management of each Gun Club within Zone II, and to discuss any matters deemed to be brought before the committee.

The following are further resolutions pertaining to Zone II:

1. The Fiscal year shall coincide with the term of the officers.
2. The officers elected at the Zone II Shoot term of office will run from 30 days following the Zone II Shoot to 30 days following the next Zone II Shoot.
3. The program for the Zone Shoot, including all options will be left up to the discretion of the Zone officers and committee.
4. The date of the Zone Shoot will be at the discretion of the Zone officers and representatives. The Zone Shoot will be held in the current target year.

### **Zone II Shoot Specifications for Hosting Gun Club**

- A. Requirements:
  - a. Minimum of four (4) program traps and one (1) practice field.
  - b. Adequate and trained shoot personnel
  - c. Food service on the grounds

- d. Adequate restrooms
- e. All major brands of Ammunition available

- B. Obligations: The host club shall bear all costs for trophies and added money

### **Zone II Officer's Responsibilities and Duties**

- A. Officers will appoint one (1) qualified member from each Zone II gun club to form a grievance committee. The chairman of said committee will be the Zone II President.
- B. Officers will appoint one (1) qualified member from each Zone II Club to form a handicap committee. The chairman of said committee will be the Zone II Vice-President.
- C. Officers will appoint varies individuals from each locale of Zone II to form the advertisement and donation committee. Said committee will be chaired by the Zone II Secretary/Treasurer.
- D. Officers will appoint a target setting committee.
- E. To produce the best feasible program possible for all clubs and shooters alike.
- F. To assist the host gun club in all areas that are specified of in any situation that is warranted.

### **Additional Requirements**

- A. Zone II expenses shall be zero. The host club shall bear all cost in printing and mailing of the program, and the cost of all trophies

and added money (if there is enough left from money raised after printing and mailing of programs and buying trophies.) The division of said added money will be at the discretion of the officers.

- B. The President of Zone II shall chair all meetings and will only vote to break a tie. Other Zone officers have full voting rights.
- C. Rotations to host the Zone II shoot are as follows; Midland Shooters Association DBA Permian Basin Shotgun Range, El Paso Skeet and Trap Club, and San Angelo Clay-Bird Association. To be placed in rotation, a club must request same at Zone II meeting. If Bylaw requirements are met and the club is accepted, they will fall behind the last club in the rotation order.
- D. ATA and TTA's Bylaws and Articles of Incorporation shall supersede Zone II's Bylaws in the event a conflict should arise.
